ARRIVAL TIME

Please be prepared to be at your venue at least 15 minutes prior to your performance time. If you wish to warm up on your instrument before performing, give yourself additional time. Look for marked, designated warm-up areas.

MUSIC

Be sure to bring **published** music scores for both the performer and any accompanist. PHOTOCOPIES are NOT allowed without a letter of permission from the publisher.

If using a score that was purchased from the internet, please bring proof of purchase with you.

PARKING

Lacombe Memorial Centre - LMC (5214 50 AVE)— There is quite a bit of parking available in the LMC parking lot for participants who are performing in the LMC. This is a free parking lot.
